  - The President, Senate, House, Supreme Court, Governors, etc.
  - Our military and wars
  - Current events
  - Texas, San Antonio, Balcones Heights
  - IWC and our Pastor and family, board, staff, ministries, families missionaries, specific needs in body and more ...
  - Blessing our youth and children
  - Personal petitions-near the end of the watch

**Where:** IWC Sanctuary

**When:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday night of every month

**Why:** Jesus prayed all night on several occasions ([Matthew 14:23](#), [Luke 6:12](#)) and we are following His example. We are showing our deep love and dependence on God and our desperation for a new move of God in our lives, at IWC, in San Antonio and beyond.
